

Don't Need Another Love Song

Count: 32

Wall: 2

Level: Improver

Music: Another Love Song - Chris Housman



One 4-Count Bridge on Wall 10

[1 – 8] WALK BACK X2, SHUFFLE BACK, R SIDE STEP TOGETHER, R CHASSE

- 1,2 Step L back, step R back
- 3&4 Step L back, step R back to meet L, step L back
- 5,6 Step R to right side, step L to meet R
- 7&8 Step R to right side, step L to meet R, step R to right side

[9 – 16] FULL TURNING BOX STEP

- 1,2 Step L forward while turning $\frac{1}{4}$ right, touch R to L (3:00)
- 3,4 Step R to right side while turning $\frac{1}{4}$ right, touch L to R (6:00)
- 5,6 Step L forward while turning $\frac{1}{4}$ right, touch R to L (9:00)
- 7,8 Step R to right side while turning $\frac{1}{4}$ right, touch L to R (12:00)

[17 – 24] V STEP, L SIDE/SLIDE TOGETHER, SHUFFLE BACK

- 1,2 Step L forward to left diagonal, step R forward to right diagonal
- 4,5 Step L back to center, step R back to center to meet L
- 5,6 Step (or slide) L to left side, step R to meet L
- 7&8 Step L back, step R back to meet L, step L back

[25 – 32] R SIDE TOE TOUCH, STEP, BACK SHUFFLE, R MONTEREY TURN W/L TOE TOUCH

- 1,2 Touch R toe to right side, step R to meet L
- 3&4 Step L back, step R back to meet L, step L back
- 5,6 Touch R toe to right side, step R to meet L while spinning $\frac{1}{2}$ turn over right shoulder (6:00)
- 7,8 Touch L to left side, touch L to R

BRIDGE: V-STEP

On Wall 10, after doing the V-Step (counts 17 – 20), repeat them one more time and continue the rest of the dance from count 21 as usual.

OPTIONAL ENDING:

At the end of the last wall, after doing the left toe touch, instead of touching to meet R, cross L behind R and make a motion with your hands like you're tossing that love song away. You don't need another one. ;)

NOTE: In case it helps you remember, each section's steps spell out "LOVE", sort of like an Etch-N-Sketch would. Section 1 is "L". Section 2 is "O". Section 3 spells "V", and begins the first half of "E". Section 4 completes the "E" and has you turn your back on it at the end by turning with the Monterey turn.
